POLICY MAKERS

- 1. Align international definition
- 2. Acknowledge the reduced CO2 emissions and resource efficiency
- 3. Introduce remanufacturing targets in waste legislation
- 4. Enforce a **2-year guarantee** on sales of used goods (B2B)
- Eliminate regulatory barriersto trade

BUSINESSES

- **1. Design** future product to enable remanufacturing
- 2. Reconfigure supply chain to enable **product take-back**
- Align staff incentives to reward value retention
- Consider a transition from product sales models to rental or performance models
